## Activities – Last month

- PRIME partnering board established. Initial baseline presentation 25/09 and identification of priorities for this year underway.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> team participation in LONU workshop
- Development of Core City Collaborative proposal to tackle health inequalities and improve performance agreed by CEOs; discussions with GH and Institute underway.
- Continuing work on WCC Assurance with focus on document review and preparation, including feedback on draft 1 of Strategic Plan from Peter Spilsbury, SHA. Confirmation of assessment team and SRC to review Leicester City and Nottinghamshire County PCTs.
- Ministerial approval for national commissioning of PNH at circa £250k per patient pa.
- Re-Launch of Be Birmingham Partnership and presentation of partnership programme. Positive initial feedback through CAA pilot and CSCI assessment of BCC A&C.
- Presented at LGC summit with Chair of Audit Commission
- Development of personalised care theme within BHWP with emphasis on 'self-directed' care
- Agreed three themes of IfH Quality and Safety work:
  - KPIs for non acute contracts
  - 'Darzi' Quality Observatory
  - Whole system movements for improvement
